Notice Concerning

Home Campfires

Hurricane Valley Fire District follows the Utah Administrative Code 307-202-6 and the International Fire Code (IFC). They require the following for home campfires:

- 1. All fires must be in a contained pit or ring.
- 2. All sparks and embers must be controlled (a screen to cover the fire may be necessary).
- 3. The pit must also have a non-flammable safety ring immediately around it that is at least 3 feet wide (no grass allowed within that safety ring).
- 4. Fires must be at least 15 feet away from any structure, combustible material, and property line.
- 5. Fires must use only clean, dry, untreated wood.
- 6. Fires must always be maintained and supervised, which includes extinguishing all fires *completely* before leaving the pit unattended.
- 7. Once fires are completely extinguished and incapable of reigniting, all ashes and other debris should be disposed of properly.

It is also recommended that a garden hose, bucket of water, or a fire extinguisher be close by.

Home campfires can be enjoyable, but they can also be dangerous. Although following these requirements will not guarantee safety, they will help.
